1. Pumpkins

(all entries apart from class 1.5 and 1.6 must be grown by the entrant)

- 1.1. Best Butternut pumpkin
- 1.2. Best Queensland Blue pumpkin
- 1.3. Best pumpkin any other variety
- 1.4. Biggest pumpkin
- 1.5. Best decorated pumpkin (not carved)
- 1.6. Best carved pumpkin

3. Cookery

Cake/cookery item incorporating home grown vegetables or fruit.

Vegetables/fruit used must be grown by the entrant).

- 3.1. Cake (20 cm round, no ring tins)
- 3.2. Scones (4)
- 3.3. Muffin (4)
- 3.4. Other

Suggestions (but not limited to):

- Carrot cake
- Chocolate Beetroot cake
- Pumpkin scones
- Raspberry Muffins
- Lemon slice
- Zucchini brownies
- Rhubarb cake

2. Garden

(all entries must be grown by the entrant)

- 2.1. Any vegetable (3 of same variety)
- 2.2. Any fruit (3 of same variety)
- 2.3. Best Garden Harvest Basket
- 2.4. Collection of herbs – 3 varieties
- 2.5. A container of the same flower type
- 2.6. A container of mixed flowers

(store bought vegetables allowed)

- 4.2. Best decorated vegetable - 6 to 8 years

5. Judges decision is final.
6. Entries must be on display until 4pm. No entries to be picked up earlier.
7. Entries to be collected between 4pm and 4.30 pm Saturday 20th April. Any entries not picked up by 4.30 pm will be discarded.
